Job Description: Statistician

Role	The Statistician is responsible for collating the results and statistics for the English Senior Fell Running Championship series of six races per year.
Main purposes of role	 To ensure that the results of English Championship races are calculated correctly and in a timely manner. To arrange for checking and publication of such results. To help manage the English Championship race series as part of the Championships subcommittee. To raise any concerns regarding eligibility or issues with the rules to the Committee at the earliest opportunity.
Key tasks	 Liaise with Race Organisers of English Championship races beforehand (e.g. to ensure correct categorisation of athletes) and obtain results afterwards. Calculate individual and team points scored in each Championship race, based on the results provided by the Race Organiser. Ensure that any questions or anomalies are raised with the Race Organiser and definitively resolved as soon as possible. Calculate aggregated individual and team points for the current season following each Championship race. Send draft results to appropriate Committee members for checking and (when complete) arrange for publication on the FRA Website and in the Fellrunner.
Required skills and facilities	 Outstanding numeracy and exceptional data manipulation skills, probably using MS Excel but with the need to import race results from Race Organisers in whatever form they arrive. Exceptional conscientiousness and attention to detail. The ability to interpret a potentially complex set of eligibility requirements and Championship rules correctly. The willingness to liaise with Race Organisers and insist that the final race results are correct.
Required liaison	The primary liaison required is with Race Organisers of the six English Championship races. Regular liaison with other members of the Championships sub-committee will also be required. Undated 27th lune 2019
