### Organisers Comments

A record turn out of seventy four runners took part in the event which was also a North East Championship race.

For some of the runners the day was one of mixed weather and mixed fortunes. The weather changed rapidly from warm pleasant sunshine to thunder showers with torrential rain and hail. The lead according to accounts also changed many times.

Jonny Malley, recently returned to the area from Sheffield University, led through the hay field and on to Barrow Law. Thereafter the leading men took turns at the front over Windy Gyle and on to Plea Knowe. A couple of “imaginative” some might say “deviant” route choices on the descent caused some discussion at the finish. But no advantage was deemed to have been gained and in a close finish Jonny Malley U23 (Dark Peak) led the way to the finish in a time of 01:03:37. He was followed by V40's Lee Bennett (Elswick) 01:03:50, and Bruce Crombie (Alnwick) 01:04:04. Cameron Taylor (Esk Valley) was 5<sup>th</sup> overall and 2<sup>nd</sup> U23.

First senior woman home in 01:18:07 was Miriam Bennett (UA (but soon to join a club)). She had a rather trying morning but managed to arrange a lift to the race at the last minute to complete the Alwinton-Windy Gyle double. Emma Bain (NFR) and Steph Scott (NFR) finished as 2<sup>nd</sup> and third ladies and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> V40's.
